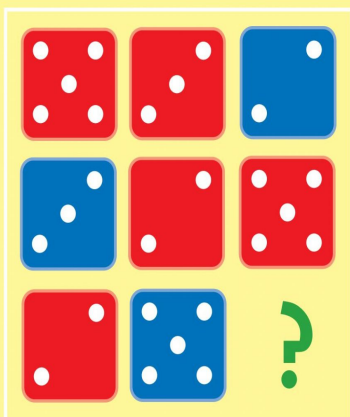

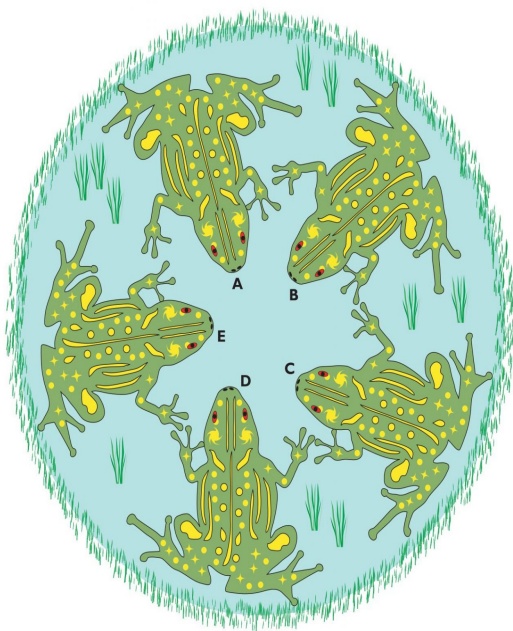

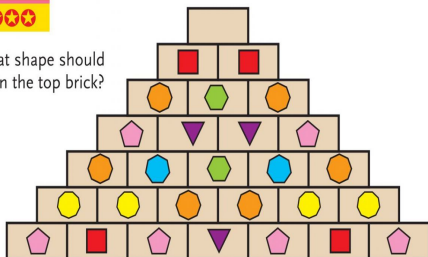
Can you spot which two frogs are identical?

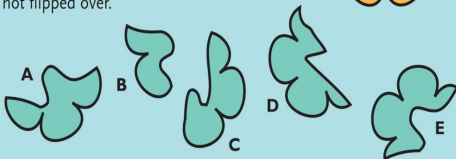
What shape should

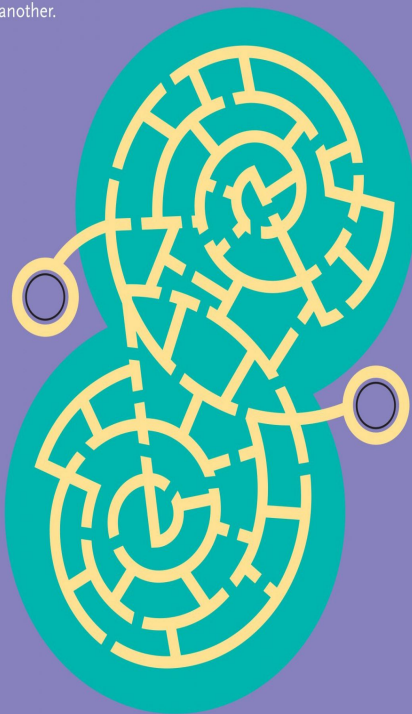

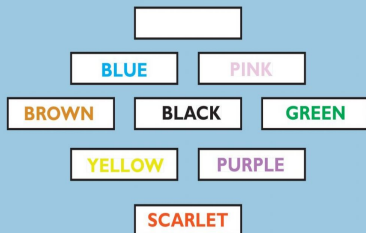
Follow the unbroken path from one tower to another.
