Introductory Note to the Reader

Before performing any spell or spiritual work, you must first choose and invoke the appropriate Pombagira for the matter you wish to address. Each Pombagira has her own specialty, temperament, spiritual domain, and energetic signature. Invoking an unsuitable entity may yield no results—whereas invoking the correct one immediately opens the path. Do not combine different Pombagiras within the same spell.

Basic procedure:

Light a candle of the appropriate color (usually red or black).

Call upon the specific Pombagira who operates in the area you require.

State your request clearly, directly, and without ambiguity.

Do not perform rituals while emotionally unstable.

Perform the spell only after the invocation.

Each work becomes stronger, more precise, and more effective when the invoked entity corresponds exactly to the nature of the request.

Lineages of Pombagiras

Some classic examples you can use as a reference:

Mary Quitéria (original name in portuguese: Maria Quitéria)

Pombagira of great strength and spiritual authority.

Functions:

Justice.

Overcoming obstacles.

Warding off negative energies.

Cutting ties and dependencies.

Opening difficult paths.

Courage, self-defense, and determination.

When you need strength, decisiveness, personal protection, and victory, work with Mary Quitéria.

Mary Mulambo (original name in portuguese: Maria Mulambo).

“Mulambo” is an African term referring to a type of cloth traditionally tied around the waist by members of certain African tribes.

One of the most beloved and accessible Pombagiras, she specializes in clearing paths and restoring happiness.

Functions:

Love in general (attraction, reconciliation, harmony).

Remove envy and bad energies.

Undo spells against you.

Prosperity, money, and abundance.

Emotional healing and self-esteem.

When you need tenderness, love, protection, and lightness in your destiny, work with Mary Mulambo.

Mary Padilha

Specialist in:

Refined seduction.

Emotional control.

Return of a relationship.

Feminine strength.

Personal power.

Undoing a rival's energy.

She is the queen of the paths of love and feminine power.

Note: The name “Maria Padilha” or “Maria Mulambo” designates a line of several Pombagiras who manifest under the same archetype and energetic vibration. Although symbolic narratives speak of a woman by this name who became a Pombagira after death, these accounts are understood as symbolic rather than literal.

There may indeed be an entity known as Maria Padilha; however, this phalanx also includes other entities who share the same energy or vibration and respond to different names, such as Mary Padilha of Souls, Mary Padilha of the Cemetery (Calunga), Mary Padilha Queen, Mary Padilha of the Seven Skirts, and others.

Pombagira Seven Skirts (Pombagira das Sete Saias)

Specialist in:

Seduction.

Immediate attraction.

Sexual magnetism.

Awakening strong desire.

Beauty and charm.

Female self-esteem.

Highly effective in spells involving passion, conquest, and personal brilliance.

Pombagira Seven Stabs (Pombagira Sete Facadas)

Specialist in:

Swift justice.

Cutting down rivals.

Driving away enemies.

Defending against spiritual attacks.

Resolving serious situations.

Freeing from betrayal.

She is incisive, swift, and protective of those who have been wronged.

Pombagira of Crossroads

(name in portuguese: Pombagira da Encruzilhada)

Specialist in:

Opening paths.

Difficult choices.

Unlocking love life.

Bringing encounters.

Paths to reconciliation.

Protecting crossroads and decisions.

She is great when life is at a standstill or when there is indecision.

Rose Skull (name in portuguese: Rosa Caveira)

Specialist in:

Deep spiritual protection.

Working with the dead and ancestry.

Cutting toxic ties.

Warding off obsessors.

Removing heavy burdens.

Spiritual justice spells.

Highly sought after by those who feel heavy burdens or energetic persecution.
