

Hollie Bowden

British designer Hollie Bowden consistently delivers projects that are characterised by her natural design language. She approaches her realisations intuitively and knows how to incorporate indigenous elements into contemporary comfort like no other. Her realisation Forest Estate, a four-bedroom Bohemian holiday home in Ibiza, is no exception. To create a serene atmosphere, Bowden opted for neutral colours and materials. Therefore, grey, and brown tones prevail, together with wood and stone. The walls and floors were finished with a mineral plaster. In terms of furniture and decoration, Bowden selected modernist pieces to counter the sobriety. She also included some design classics, such as the work of sculptor Barbara Hepworth and painter Sergei Jensen. Next to this, Bowden collaborated with local artists who created ceramic sculptures that remind of tools. In short, Forest Estate is a beautiful piece of bohemian design that combines traditional pieces and modern elements into a harmonious whole.
