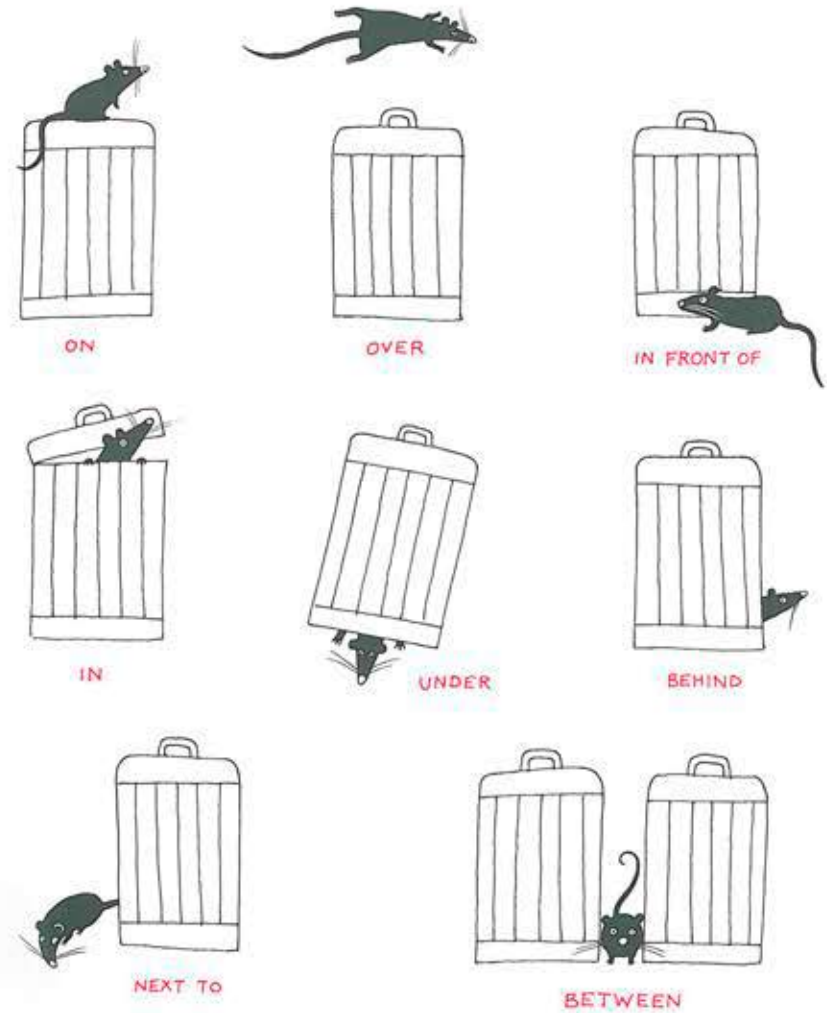
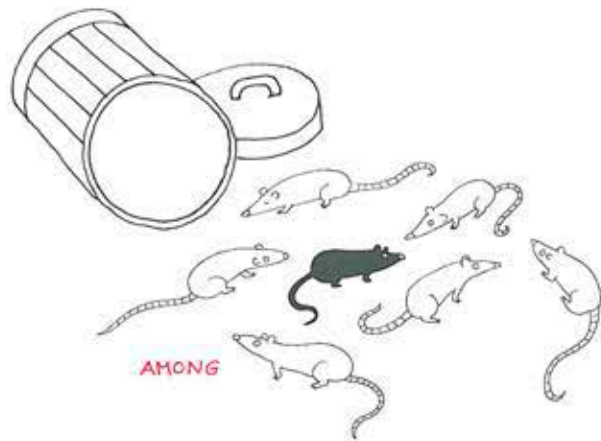


Place PREPOSITIONS



SIMPLE PRESENT

SUBJECT + VERB

You need...



The **SIMPLE PRESENT** is used to make statements about the present time.

For permanent facts that are always true: *The night is dark.*

For present facts that are true now: *I feel happy.*

For habitual actions: *I get up late.*



negative

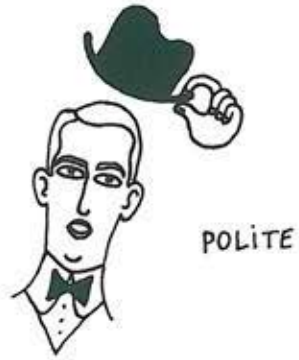
To make a Simple Past negative use:
SUBJECT + DID NOT | DIDN'T + INFINITIVE without "to"
I didn't go...

DID + NOT + DIDN'T



question

To make a Simple Past question use:
DID + SUBJECT + INFINITIVE without "to"
Did you love her?



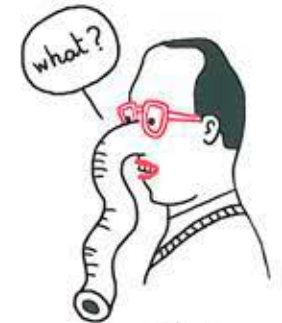

YOU CAN BE...

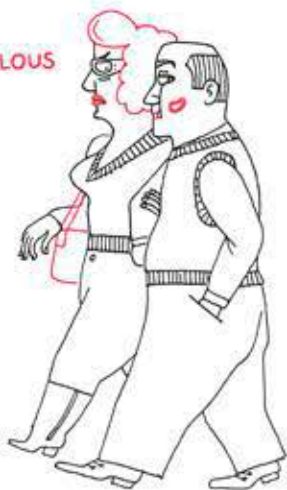

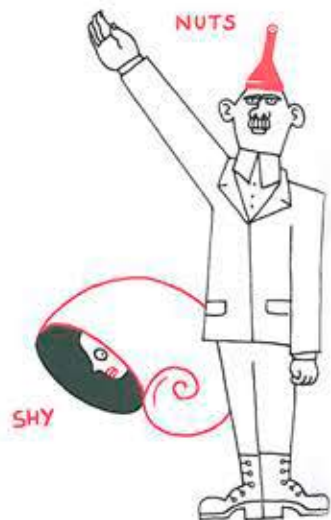
